

## Twin Towns Snooker Club Annual General Meeting 13th March 2023 President's Report



I would like to express the appreciation of the Snooker Club to the Board of Twin Towns Services Club for their support during the year. As always, they have readily assisted whenever requested and this is very much appreciated.

Thank you to the management and staff of Club Banora, they have also been supportive of our Club and must be commended.

At the start of 2022 season, the committee were looking at ways of increasing our membership numbers and just by engaging in conversation with people that were playing and interested, along with our efforts with the juniors, the membership increased from 72 members and 2 juniors in March to 81 members and 11 juniors in December.

Banora club are also proud to have Jessica Woods as a member and she managed to win the Women's Australian Nationals for an incredible 7<sup>th</sup> time. Jessica also entered into the Ladies world snooker championship along with Tea Smith, well done to both of you.

We made a commitment that all of the annual tournaments would be completed by the end of the year and this was accomplished along with an extra Eamonn Duff tournament, which had to be reorganised from 2021 due to NSW government policies. Many thanks to Peter Campbell, our Eamonn Duff ambassador, who arranges for all of our sponsors for the event.



The snooker club proudly supports the Far North Coast Snooker Association as well as the Queensland Billiards & Snooker Association with some of their tournaments. We entered a team into the FNCSA team's event and came out as champions. We also reintroduced the Queensland Masters Billiards Championship which we hope will be a regular feature in our calendar.
