Member of other affiliated Clubs \$60

Nomination is not confirmed until entry fee is paid

Semi-Final and Final matches of Main and Consolation will be played on the last day at the event – Monday 3rd October

- 1) The tournament to be held under the Rules of Play & Code of Ethics as set out in the Australian Billiards & Snooker Council Handbook.
- 2) Entrants must be a financial member of an affiliated Club or with a regional or State body that is affiliated with the ABSC.
- 3) The tournament is open to a maximum of 54 entrants.
- 4) The Tournament Director (TD) reserves the right to refuse entry to the tournament.
- 5) Only paid entries will be placed in the draw.
- 6) The top 8 players on handicap will be seeded.
- 7) The Tournament Committee reserves the right to alter handicaps after each respective player has played their 1st match.
- 8) Dress Code: Minimum of long trousers, collared shirts, dress leather shoes. No jeans or lookalike, cargo pants, joggers, shorts or shirts with offensive slogans. Ladies equivalent attire. Full tournament dress for Semi Finals and Finals in Main Events only.
- 9) First games are to start at 9.30am (NSW time) each day.
- 10) Players must be available to play at the scheduled times. Players not in attendance after 15 minutes will forfeit one frame. After a further 15 minutes the match will be forfeited. This rule also applies to players not being correctly attired.
- 11) All Main Event rounds up to and including the semi-finals best of 3 frames. The Final is to be best of 5 frames.
- 12) Consolation Plate. Open to any player who loses their first match free entry. Matches will generally commence within 2 hours of losing your Main Event first match.
- 13) Preliminary games in the Consolation Plate are one frame only. The Final will be best of three frames. If behind on schedule, then only 6 reds will be used per frame and handicaps halved (Consolation Plate only)
- 14) Losers are to referee the next match except the Final. A charge of \$10 applies if the loser fails to referee as required under this rule.
- 15) Winners prizemoney is approximately \$1250, Runner up \$700. All other prizemoney levels are dependent upon the number of entries received and may be reduced if entries are less than 54.
- 16) Payment of prizemoney will be by cash on the final day.
- 17) No practice permitted on the tables during the tournament.
- 18) All players are expected to adhere to the COVID plan at place at the venue.

<u>High Breaks</u>: Three \$25.00 handicap high break prizes will be available. Handicaps as follows: 0-20, 21-40, 41+.

One outright highest break prize \$50 - all players eligible.
